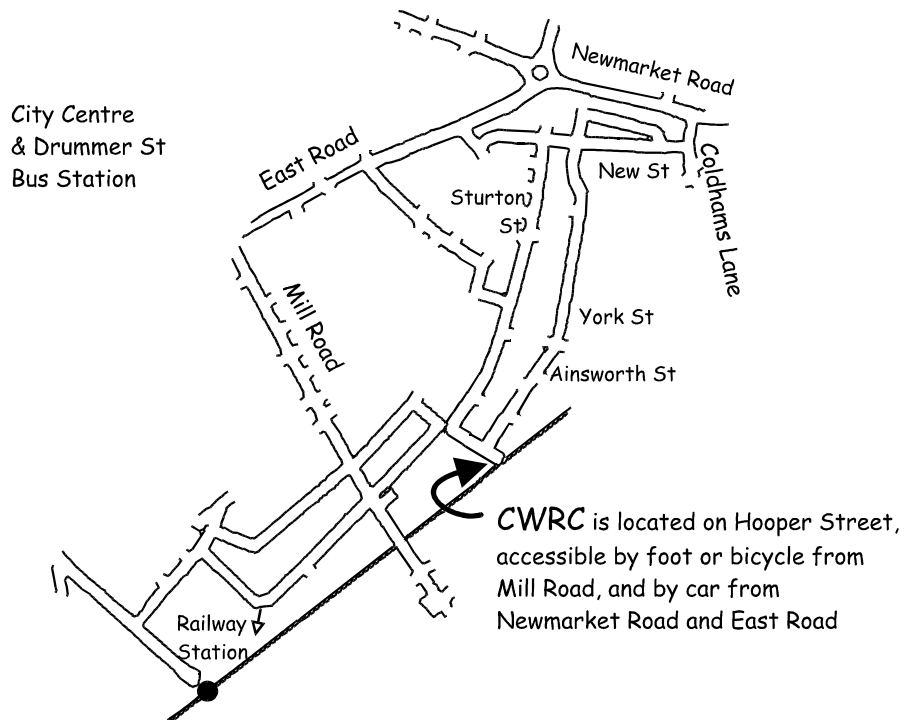

Leading learning and skills

English & Maths Courses at CWRC

Our English and Maths classes are small, relaxed and supportive. You will decide with your tutor which subjects you want to study and you will be able to work at your own pace, with an individually agreed learning programme.

Maths courses are for women who lack confidence in their maths, as well as those who wish to be able to help their school age children. The courses include practice in multiplying & dividing, fractions, measurement, data handling and money.

English courses are for women whose first language is English, and include practice in grammar, spelling, and letter writing. Some students may also study English Literature - Short Story, Drama or Poetry.

Days and times of courses

All courses run weekdays for 10 weeks. The sessions are either morning or afternoon, with a short break for refreshments. We offer classes at two levels:

Exploring and Developing (Entry level on the national curriculum)


English - Wednesday mornings (9.15 am – 12.15 pm)

Maths – day to be confirmed (1 – 3 pm)

Progressing (working towards level 1 or 2 on the national curriculum)

English – Wednesday afternoons (1 – 3 pm)

Maths – day to be confirmed (9.15 am – 12.15 pm)

Course fees

These English and maths courses are fully funded by the Learning & Skills Council. They are free for any women who are eligible for LSC-funding. If you are an Overseas Learner, you will have to pay fees (please ask for details)

Eligibility

In order to be eligible for LSC (UK Government) funding, you must be legally resident in the UK or EU (normally this means 3 years residence). Course fees for Overseas Learners will be higher. Please bring your passport to the Centre when enrolling on courses. Contact the Courses Administrator for further information.

Enrolment

CWRC courses are open to all women – there are no formal entry requirements. After you contact the centre we will arrange an Enrolment Appointment. During this appointment you will fill out an enrolment form and we will make sure that you are enrolling on the right course for you at this time. We will also check that you are eligible for the course; and make sure that we are able to offer you any additional services appropriate to your needs, such as crèche places.

CWRC Crèche

The on-site crèche is run by experienced co-ordinators and sessional workers. Child care is FREE to all women using the facilities of the centre. The crèche is open during classroom hours.

Other courses and workshops at CWRC

CWRC offers a wide range of courses and workshops in subjects such as creative writing, woodwork, self defence and digital photography. Please be aware that not all courses at CWRC are free. Contact us to find out the latest news and information, or visit our website at www.cwrc.org.uk
