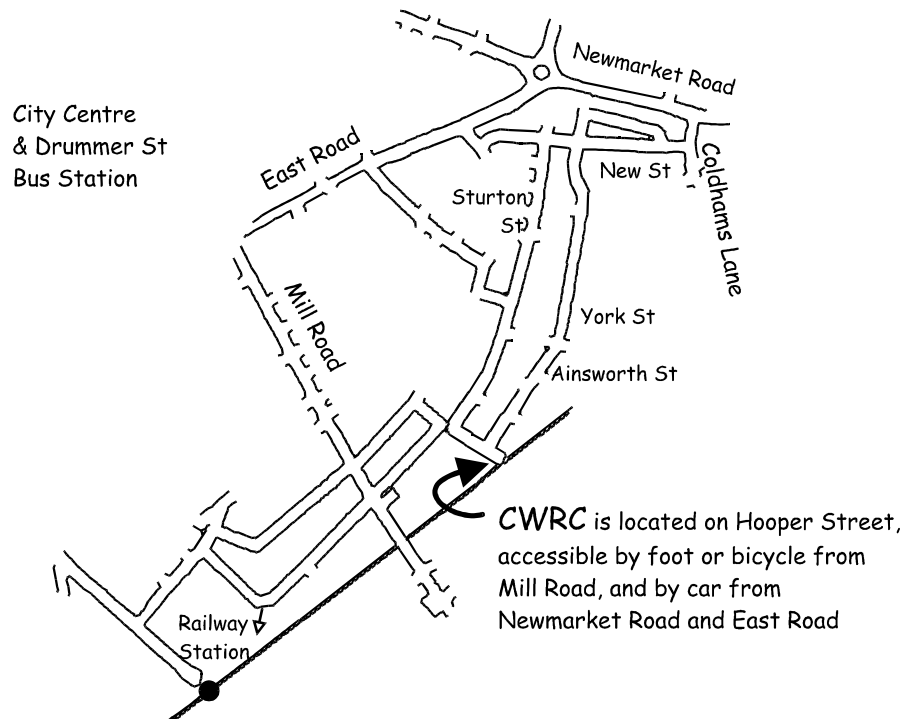

Leading learning and skills

English as a Second or Other Language (ESOL)

ESOL courses are for women who have settled in this country, and cover a wide range of topics, such as living in the community and getting a job.

CWRC runs ESOL courses leading to nationally recognised qualifications. We will help you to decide on your level when you come to enrolment.

ESOL classes will help you to improve your Reading and Writing skills, including spelling, grammar and punctuation, understanding what you read, and writing letters, notes and messages.

The tutor will help you to improve your Speaking and Listening skills, including everyday language and vocabulary, pronunciation, listening for meaning and discussion.

Days and times of ESOL courses

Our main ESOL courses run weekdays for 10 weeks, from 9:15 am to 3 pm, with lunch from 12:15 – 1 pm.

The following ESOL courses are available:

- Entry 1 - Mondays
- Entry 2 - Fridays
- Entry 3 - Tuesdays
- Level 1 - Wednesdays
- Level 2 - Thursdays

Other ESOL courses

We sometimes run a **pre-entry ESOL** course for women who are just beginning to learn English.

We also run additional classes from time to time, such as our Reading & Writing Class or 2 day courses to help you with your spelling. Please check our website for updates.

ESOL Course Fees

These courses are part-funded by the LSC – see note on eligibility. The cost for each course is £75 (or £25 concession) for women who are eligible for LSC-funding and £300 for Overseas Learners.

Concessions are available for women on means tested benefits.

Enrolment

CWRC courses are open to all women – there are no formal entry requirements. After you contact the centre we will arrange an Enrolment Appointment. During this appointment you will fill out an enrolment form and we will make sure that you are enrolling on the right course for you at this time. We will also check that you are eligible for the course; and make sure that we are able to offer you any additional services appropriate to your needs, such as crèche places.

Eligibility

In order to be eligible for LSC (UK Government) funding, you must be legally resident in the UK or EU (normally this means 3 years residence). Course fees for Overseas Learners will be higher. Please bring your passport to the Centre when enrolling on courses. Contact the Courses Administrator for further information.

CWRC Crèche

The on-site crèche is run by experienced co-ordinators and sessional workers. Child care is FREE to all women using the facilities of the centre. The crèche is open during classroom hours.

Other courses and workshops at CWRC
